Leading ~40 engineers in fully remote, cross-functional platform teams delivering enterprise administration, auditability, and premium data storage capabilities, supporting \$1B+ in annual revenue. Ramped into a complex org during a period of transition and high volatility, tailoring leadership to teams at very different stages of maturity.

I stabilised Admin Center delivery with a mix of tactical and operational improvements, and authored a strategic realignment from feature factory to platform, enabling other teams to self-serve their admin interfaces, reducing bottlenecks. The team delivered 2 key features (Seat Request Flow and Enterprise Plan Management) for plan migrations to a new pricing model.

In Audit, I supported a geographical transition of responsibilities, enabled an architectural overhaul for availability and scalability, and advocated for reframing auditability as a first-class NFR — flipping the model from the Audit team chasing coverage, to product teams owning event compliance.

Achievements

- Stabilised and recovered Admin Center delivery post-missed commitments;
- Authored and gained SLT alignment on Admin Center's "Platform, Not Content" strategy;
- Delivered Seat Request Flow and EPM v2, accelerating licensing migration (66% vs 60% target);
- Initiated the shift to event ownership as a product-team NFR for Audit.

Hired to build a new serverless platform for a CRM strategy, then promoted to lead eCommerce. Following the merger with Netherlands-based Albelli, I united 6 teams (~55 people across UK, NL, ES, and UA) into a single domain while driving commercial goals and a major replatforming across .NET, Node.js, AWS, a 20-year-old Perl monolith, and modern event-driven microservices.

I partnered with senior leadership on domain strategy and budget, and led the discovery for the post-replatforming operating model, proposing a reorg aligned with team topologies.

Achievements

- Enabled 2 full system replatformings, migrating ~50% of customers to the target platform while maintaining commercial and operational KPIs;
- Mentored Senior Engineers into Engineering Manager roles;
- Managed teams through a merger, re-orgs, redundancies, budget constraints, and in active war zones.

My first platform role, and the one where I started to branch outside technical influence and into line management. I led the team rebuilding Vogue Runway's CMS across 11 markets — a system where seconds mattered, as catwalk images had to be live almost as they were taken. After a merger with our US sibling, the challenge shifted to content syndication: enabling magazines worldwide to access, translate, and republish each other's editorial content, alongside an AI-based image tagging tool.

First hire by the new CTO. Drove a technical and cultural transformation, shifting the department from execution to problem-solving. Delivered production-ready proofs of concept to validate a stack transition and led a product team interim, while defining the hiring process for the role.

Between 2010 and 2016, I (co)founded and ran one of the main European Front-End Conferences: From the Front. I took care of communication and customer care since day one, and worked each year on the lineup, call for papers and inclusivity policies.

I spoke at several conferences, including Paris Web in 2011, Front Trends in Warsaw in 2015 and 2017, DIBI London in 2016, React Advanced London in 2021. I gave keynotes to the Italian CssDay (2019) and JsDay (2024), and React Alicante, where I spoke in 2018 and 2019.

Brief stint due to the London office closing, but formative — a mission-driven, UX and data-led company that shaped my engineering mindset. Championed performance improvements and mentored junior colleagues.

Mobile-first companion web experience. Led the modernisation of the front-end architecture.

First external hire; took full ownership of the front end working remotely with the two technical founders.
